Several national prayer networks, Christian ministries and organisations including Family Policy Institute has organised the "Parliament Prayer Day" initiative to pray for South Africa.

The national Christian leadership strongly urge believers across the country to put a minimum of one hour aside on 24 November between 12h00 – 16h00 to pray in unity for the nation.

Please gather together wherever you are on Friday 24 November in small or large groups during lunch breaks, in homes, Churches or elsewhere and join the Christian leadership in Parliament as they call out to God in repentance, intercessions and prayer for the peace of South Africa.

Change is already taking place across the border. The Church in Zimbabwe is praying for a peaceful transition to a post-Mugabe era that will hopefully restore that nation's democratic institutions.

You and I must do the same for South Africa! God has already exposed the many things done in the dark and will continue to expose the evil deeds of wicked and
