Sexual Exploitation & Abuse Of Women & Children Must Be Eradicated Now!

The “16 Days of Activism of No Violence Against Women & Children” Campaign kicked off on 25 November and runs until 10 December to generate awareness about the intolerable high levels of violence, sexual exploitation and abuse of vulnerable women and children in South Africa.

The statistics of rape, sexual exploitation and abuse of women and children are horrific. Teen pregnancies are rampant and young women are most susceptible to HIV/AIDS infections.

No believer in Jesus Christ can tolerate this scourge or ignore the terrible injustices perpetuated against the most vulnerable members of society. Tragically these stats are not declining.

Sexual exploitation and violence and abuse of women and children cannot be eradicated until we eradicate their social degradation through the evils of pornography and prostitution.

Family Policy Institute and the “Coalition To End Sexual Exploitation South Africa” (CESESA) is finalising its Policy Proposal on Prostitution Law Reform to submit to the ANC, ANC Women’s League, COSATU, the Gender Commission and all the opposition political parties in Parliament.

We strongly advocate for the outlawing of all forms of sexual exploitation of women and children in South Africa. We also strongly urge government to outlaw the distribution, access to and consumption of pornography that is proven to demean and degrade women and children.

As long as women and increasingly younger girls are portrayed as sex objects in pornography and the popular media, the high rates of sexual violence against them will not decrease.

In addition, the FPI/CESESA Policy Proposal will be submitted to the Multi-Party Women's Caucus who appear to be lobbied aggressively by sexual rights and prostitution groups.

The liberal mainstream media openly supports free access to pornography, decriminalised prostitution and the legitimisation and glamorisation of sexual promiscuity. They often report on the tragic incidences of sexual violence against women and children but fail to connect the dots.

There are mountains of evidence proving that regular consumption of pornography is destructive to men, women and children and [seriously undermines marriage and the](#)

Pornography is prostitution for mass consumption. When women and children are objectified as mere sex objects on our streets and in the media - the consequences are devastating.

A [New Report](#) commissioned by Family Policy Institute's ally, Family Watch International confirm that "Comprehensive Sexuality Education" (CSE) is not only ineffective but harmful to children.

FPI will use the facts contained in this Report to lobby for the complete withdrawal of CSE from our public schooling system to protect children from the harm of this diabolical perversion.
