2018 is the year of new beginnings. I had the privilege of speaking to several Christian leaders from various backgrounds across the nation - about their expectations for the New Year.

I was encouraged that the vast majority were upbeat about the future prospects for South Africa. Most leaders are positive about political, economic and spiritual change in the country.

There are encouraging signs that newly elected ANC president; Cyril Ramaphosa is fulfilling his promise to tackle widespread corruption and maladministration in the ruling party and the country. Apparently, President Zuma's recall as president of South Africa is also imminent.

Last year, [Cyril Ramaphosa quoted from my newsletter](#) at the SACP National Congress and expressed his “pain” at what I wrote about widespread government corruption.

Mr Ramaphosa has acted speedily and decisively since his election at the ANC Conference in December 2017 to stem the rot of corruption that spread to almost every sector of society.

President Zuma announced the Judicial Commission of Inquiry that will [investigate “State Capture” allegations](#) highlighted in the Public Protector's Report. Significantly, Chief Justice Mogoeng Mogoeng and not Mr Zuma nominated the judge tasked with leading this vital Inquiry.

Other positive moves instigated by Mr Ramaphosa are the appointment of a new board at Eskom and the firing of numerous scandal tainted officials, the [NPA and Asset Forfeiture Unit's sudden moves on Gupta linked companies](#) and the purge of Zuma linked criminals embedded at the SAPS.

If media reports are true, once President Jacob Zuma is recalled, a major cabinet reshuffle is expected in which corrupt and incompetent Zuma loyalist will be fired - and hopefully prosecuted.

The positive moves in government will undoubtedly stabilise SA politics and will trigger an economic upturn in the country that will in turn promote better social harmony.

Millions of Christians have interceded for the peace and prosperity of South Africa over the past years. We will see God faithfully answer these prayers this year! Keep believing, keep praying!
