Today I launch my six-month funding campaign to ensure Family Policy Institute (FPI) can fulfil its God-given mandate to defend the family and advance Biblical values in South Africa.

I must raise R350,000 urgently to support our vital pro-family work in SA until 30 June 2018. These finances will also keep our critical TV and radio programs on the nations airwaves.

Although there are positive moves to clamp down on corruption and the brazen looting of taxpayer money, several dire threats against faith, family and religious freedoms persist.

The “Hate Crimes” Bill is being finalised by the Department of Justice and presents a major threat to the veracity and authority of the Bible. We must defeat this draconian Bill.

The media reports opposition political party, the Congress of the People ([COPE](#)) has tabled a private members Bill to compel all state marriage officers to officiate at same-sex “weddings.”

Its aim is to declare unconstitutional any objections made on religious grounds. This means, ministers of religion that are marriage officers may be forced to solemnise counterfeit marriage.

More shocking was the [ANC’s endorsement of decriminalised prostitution](#) at its 54th National Elective Conference in Dec last year. The ANC claims to fight for the safety and dignity of women in SA. However, they flatly ignored the recommendations of the SA Law Reform Commission’s Report on Adult Prostitution that warned against decriminalising prostitution in South Africa.

Last year, I sent the 22-page "Policy Proposal on Prostitution Law Reform" developed by CESESA to the ANC, ANC Women’s League, COSATU the SACP and the Gender Commission. It appears this vital document was blatantly ignored to promote the interest of certain groups.

Significantly however, I have been invited to speak at the [“Global End Sexual Exploitation Summit”](#) in Washington DC in April. I will meet with some of the worlds top activists - working to end all forms of sexual exploitation of women and children - to develop a strategy for South Africa.

I will also meet with experts on [“Comprehensive Sexuality Education”](#) in the US. This is a major threat against children in SA that must be stopped. We are currently working on a strategy to inform parents about this diabolical agenda to stop its implementation in our schools.

These and other threats against faith, family and religious freedoms must be exposed and defeated. However, FPI’s finances are dangerously low which seriously inhibits our abilities.
