ANC/Sexual Rights Activists Attempt To Subvert SALRC Report on Adult Prostitution!

The Multi-Party Women’s Caucus held a Summit at Parliament on 5 March to [hear submissions](#) on the South African Law Reform Commissions (SALRC) Report on Adult Prostitution.

The [SALRC Report on Adult Prostitution](#) was released in May 2017 following a nine-year study. The Commission warned against decriminalised prostitution and refuted the claims made by pro-prostitution groups that the policy helps protect the human rights of women in prostitution.

Despite the comprehensive SALRC study and its recommendations, the ANC passed a resolution at its 54th National Conference in December 2017 endorsing decriminalised prostitution.

Global research overwhelmingly indicates that decriminalised prostitution is a [disastrous policy](#). The only people that benefit are pimps, crime syndicates and brothel owners.

The SALRC Report warns of the dangers of decriminalised prostitution in SA. High rates of poverty, unemployment and exploitation of women and children make them particularly vulnerable.

Significantly, in a case in which the criminalisation of prostitution was challenged by brothel owner, Ellen Jordan in the highest court in the land, *S v Jordan* (2002) the Constitutional Court ruled that criminalising prostitution is constitutional and does not infringe on women's rights.

I sent the Caucus a 22-page [submission](#) on behalf of the “The Coalition To End Sexual Exploitation South Africa” (CESESA). CESESA members also made submissions at the Summit in Parliament.

Tragically, the Central Methodist Mission in Cape Town endorsed the deception of pro-prostitution groups by claiming that [“Jesus was the first to decriminalise sex work.”](#)

Distorting Scripture to support an alleged social justice objective is nothing new in South Africa. But this manipulation and perversion of Jesus words is particularly egregious.

Research shows decriminalisation expands the sex industry. It never breaks the links

between organised crime and prostitution. Many more vulnerable women and children will be lured into a life of exploitation, abuse and misery if the sex industry is decriminalised in South Africa.

The Church must speak up. Millions of vulnerable women and children are at risk. Scripture commands we speak for those who cannot speak for themselves (Proverbs 31:8).
