On 23 and 24 April I launched my countrywide "Watchmen on the Wall" Pastors Briefings in Durban KZN entitled, "Reshaping South Africa's Future" to inform and update SA's leaders.

Over the next several months and leading up to the General Elections in 2019, I will be briefing Pastors and leaders in Johannesburg, Pretoria, Bloemfontein, Durban, Kimberley, Port Elizabeth, East London and Cape Town. I will also visit smaller towns across the country to inform and educate leaders about the unfolding political situation in South Africa.

I attended most of the major prayer gatherings that took place across the nation over the past five years. The one thing millions of Christian citizens from all walks of life agree on in prayer, is the transformation of our politics. Corrupt and self-serving politicians have degraded the nation.

Christians called out to God for a "godly Parliament where the name of Jesus Christ is honoured." We also prayed for "godly men and women of integrity in positions of authority."

The countrywide leadership discussions will focus on how to make this prayer a reality.

Some of the critical issues the Church must confront are the revised "Hate Crimes" Bill and what government's real intention with land expropriation without compensation is.

Bible-believing Christians are grossly underrepresented in Parliament or are completely ignored. Consequently, Biblical values and principles have steadily declined in society.

The devastating increase in corruption, maladministration, sexual immorality and

injustice is a consequence of the worldview of the men and women currently in authority.

The ruling party's policies on abortion-on-demand, "sexual rights," the sexualisation of young children, parental rights and religious freedoms must be urgently addressed.

The Bible declares, "When the righteous rule (are in authority), the people rejoice. But when the wicked rule (are in authority) the people groan," Proverbs 29:2. Are we rejoicing or groaning?

The answer to this question must determine your and my course of action over the next 12 months. We have prayed for change. Now we must plan and execute that change.
