Christians Relegated To Second Class Citizens In SA For Expressing Biblical Beliefs & Convictions!

I write this newsletter from Durban where Arlene and I concluded our 5-city “Pastors Briefings” tour that took us to Bloemfontein, Kimberley, Pretoria, Johannesburg and Durban.

I shared the vision to impact our political sector in 2019 with more than two thousand Pastors and civil society leaders in these five major cities. The response was phenomenal.

Christians have become second-class citizens in SA. The religious beliefs and convictions of Christian citizens are not only ignored by government - they are increasingly suppressed. Christians are often bullied and punished for publicly expressing their beliefs and convictions.

The ANC ruled government have revealed their commitment to provide special rights and protections for homosexuals.” They are fast tracking the “Prevention & Combating of Hate Speech & Hate Crimes” Bill to specifically criminalise the Scriptures that condemn sexual sin.

The [DA Mayor of JHB has suspended a Christian member](#) of the Johannesburg City Council for declaring her friendship with Israel after DA MP, Yusuf Carrim called for her to be charged.

The DA is also dragging George Mayor, Melvin Naik through a disciplinary process for [expressing his Biblical convictions about homosexuality](#). Apparently, Christians in the DA do not possess the right to disagree with the homosexual lifestyle nor do they have the right to express it.

But the DA does finance, endorse and promote a [“gay pride parade”](#) in Cape Town in which minor children are publicly used to legitimise and celebrate the homosexual lifestyle.

You and I have to change this. Free speech and religious freedoms are guaranteed in the SA Constitution. However, these freedoms appear to be severely curtailed for Christian citizens.

If Bible-believing Christians will not defend and protect their rights to free speech and religious freedoms – nobody will. There is an alarming rise in anti-Christian bigotry in South Africa.

That is why I am working hard to ensure we significantly increase the numbers of Bible-believing Christians in Parliament in 2019. We must amplify the voice of righteousness & truth!
