State Attacks Against Biblical Beliefs & Convictions - Alarmingly On The Rise!

Family Policy Institute (FPI) celebrated its 10th Anniversary on 7 July 2018. Arlene and I stand in awe of God’s faithfulness, guidance and supernatural provision over the past ten years.

We launched the ministry on 7 July 2008 with little else but our faith and the belief the call of God was sufficient to guide us through the challenges as we pioneered this new work.

As Arlene and I reflect on the past ten years of contending for faith, family and freedom in South Africa, we are deeply grateful to God for His grace, mercy and faithfulness to our family.

However, the critical battle to defend the natural family and defend and protect the constitutional rights of Christians to freely express their Biblical beliefs and convictions continues.

Family Policy Institute joins with many other prominent Christian organisations to fight a new and serious onslaught against the autonomy of the Christian Church in South Africa.

Christian attorney, Teresa Conradie has formed the "Alliance Defending the Autonomy of Christian Churches" (ADACSA) to defend and protect the rights of Churches and other religious groups to govern their internal affairs according to their interpretation of their religious doctrine.

The issue before the Court is the 2016 decision by the General Synod of the Dutch Reformed Church (DRC) pertaining to the authority of its congregations to make independent decisions relating to same-sex marriages. However, it has morphed into a case that potentially challenges the ability of each denomination, church or religious grouping.

This situation now threatens Church autonomy because of a (friend of the court) application by the Commission for Gender Equality. The CGE is asking the Court to find that, from a constitutional point of view, religious organisations should not have the discretion to decide whether or not to recognise same-sex civil unions, marriage or relationships.

If the Court rules in favour of the CGE, Churches and religious groupings will be stripped of their rights to govern their internal affairs according to their own faith doctrines.

The attacks on the Biblical beliefs, convictions and doctrines of the Christian Church are escalating alarmingly in South Africa. Biblical Christianity is increasingly being singled out as an intolerable obstacle and threat to the diabolical agenda of [sexual rights radicals](#).

The ANC, DA and [Cope](#) have clearly indicated their [solidarity with radical homosexual and abortion activists](#). They have also launched attacks against the rights of Christians to freely express their Biblical beliefs and convictions in public. Christians are being bullied into silence.

God has given me a compelling vision to impact our government with righteousness, truth and justice in 2019. I will share my "next ten-year" vision in my following Newsletter.
