Godly Governance in South Africa is No Longer An Option - It's A Critical Necessity!

Arlene and I depart for Durban, KZN on Tuesday 21 August for a busy week of Pastors Briefings, strategy meetings and speaking engagements to advance the vision of Godly Governance.

I will address Pastors Forums in Pietermaritzburg, Phoenix and Port Shepstone. I also speak at events around KZN including the "Engaging the Times" Summit at the Protea Hotel in Durban.

I am making the case for the critical need for Godly Governance in South Africa. Christian citizens have tried voting for a "stronger opposition" to the ANC with disappointing results.

The events of the past five years strongly indicate South Africa desperately needs the intervention and competent leadership of Godly men and women of integrity in all levels of government.

The Judicial State Capture Inquiry kicked off on 20 Aug. I am convinced the degree of corruption, fraud and the looting of state coffers the inquiry will expose will shock hard working citizens.

If you ever doubted South Africa's need for Godly Governance, the escalating assault on the sanctity of life, faith, family and religious freedoms should convince you.

Besides facilitating endemic state corruption, the ruling party's policies on land reform, parental authority, religious freedoms and economic transformation are disastrous for South Africa.

ACDP MP, Cheryllyn Dudley said, "The Department of Basic Education's policy on [Home Schooling](#) is a result of failed consultations. Apparently, declining educational standards are for all.

The DA are not faring any better. Massive municipal service hikes in the Western Cape, drawn out and damaging leadership conflicts and the party's solidarity with the LGBTQ movement that motivates attacks on the beliefs and convictions of Christians has exposed its true ideology.

The EFF have resorted to vulgar racial attacks on white and Indian citizens to reinforce its questionable credibility as a pro-poor party fighting for "radical economic transformation."

COPE's Deidre Carter has tabled a Bill in Parliament that compels state marriage officers to officiate at same-sex "marriages" [regardless of their religious beliefs](#) and convictions.

In addition, COPE's ["End of Life" Bill](#) aims to legalise euthanasia in SA. Euthanasia has been used in Europe to manipulate terminally ill people to kill themselves for financial reasons.

The Commission for Gender Equality's (CGE) challenge against Church Autonomy begins in the North Gauteng High Court on 21 August. The "Alliance Defending the Autonomy of Churches South Africa" (ADACSA) [will defend](#) the Church's right to govern its affairs autonomously.

The CGE argues the Christian Church must not have the legal right to make decisions on homosexuality etc in accordance with its own Biblical beliefs and doctrines.

As you will see from the above, Godly Governance is no longer an option for Christian citizens - it is a critical necessity. Pray, stand and act for righteousness and truth in South Africa.
