This is my final funding appeal for 2018 which, coincidentally coincides with “Giving Tuesday” on 27 Nov - a global day set aside to encourage support of the efforts of charity’s and NGO’s.

“Giving Tuesday” traditionally follows the shopping frenzy of “Black Friday.” It urges people to acknowledge the selfless efforts of organisations working tirelessly for the good of society.

For more than ten years, Family Policy Institute (FPI) has been at the forefront of the battle for faith, family, and religious freedoms. We have consistently punched above our weight.

I launched my last six-month fundraising initiative in July 2018 to ensure we raise the finances we need to fund our critical pro-family and Bible based media work in South Africa.

I am deeply grateful to our partners in this ministry. We cannot do what we do without your prayers, partnership and sacrificial giving. Thank you for your loyal and valued support.

Sadly however, our six-month fundraising initiative did not do well. As of today’s date our deficit is R236, 800. This is the largest deficit FPI suffered at this stage in the past ten years.

Thankfully, FPI supporters in the US have pledged \$5000 (R70, 000) to help us achieve our funding goals by 14 December 2018. However, we must still raise the outstanding R166, 800 within two weeks or be forced to cut back on critical pro-family and Bible-based media initiatives.

Foreign-funded anti-Christian and anti-family NGO’s are planted in South Africa to change our value system to make their radical ideology of sexual rights more acceptable. These include the redefinition of marriage, family and gender norms and the sexual indoctrination of children.

These heavily funded groups are working diligently to transform our political, academic, media, judicial and educational systems to advance their diabolical agenda in South Africa.

I am working to expose these threats against faith, family and religious freedoms.

FPI's TV programs and social media initiatives are a critical tool in the battle for truth over deception.

FPI works with local and international organisations to defend the family and promote Biblical values in society. We also work to protect young children from sexual indoctrination.
