Critically however, FPI received just R35,600 during April. Thank you for giving. We deeply appreciate every donation. However, we are lagging behind our six-month fundraising goals by R260,500 with just two months till our deadline on 30 June 2019.

FPI depends entirely on donations from our friends and partners in this critical ministry. We work tirelessly to defend the family and advance Biblical values in Parliament, the media and general society.

Our finances are running dangerously low as a result of a significant increase in our workload. However, FPI's income has not kept pace with the increase in demand for its services and expertise.

As a result of the slow-down in income, I must raise R130,250 in May and June respectively to ensure our vital pro-family work continues uninterrupted in South Africa. Your support of this ministry also keeps our critical Bible-based TV programs, "Salt & Light" and "Watchmen on the Wall" on the airwaves.

I received an invitation from the "UN Family Rights Caucus" to speak at a major

pro-family event at the United Nations (UN) in New York on 15 May 2019. Entitled, [“It Takes a Family”](#) the event observes the UN designated *“International Day of Families.”* I will represent South Africa and the continent of Africa and will speak on the *“Significance of the Family in Africa.”*

This global forum provides a unique opportunity to make compelling arguments for pro-family policies to UN member-states – many of whom will be in attendance. South Africa is the only African nation that consistently votes against the family at the UN. I trust God my talk will encourage South Africa to join the African bloc in its support for the family.

In addition, as the African member of the *“UN Family Rights Caucus”* I applied for 'Consultative Status' at the UN to participate in critical debates on the family and religious freedoms. My application was deferred three times. I now have an opportunity to personally attend the UN Committee on NGOs deliberations – for the first time – on 20 May and can hopefully finalise FPI’s application.

FPI is also working on a summary of the SA Law Reform Commission (SALRC) [Discussion Paper on Sexual Offences – Children and Pornography](#). We will focus our efforts on mobilizing and equipping Christian citizens to speak decisively on this critical issue.

The SALRC has done great work investigating the harmful consequences of children accessing pornography. Its draft Bill and recommendations to government will significantly strengthen SA’s laws to better protect children from access to harmful online content and from sexual exploitation and abuse.
