On 8 May 2019 millions of South African voters will go to the polls in the country's 6<sup>th</sup> Democratic General Elections to make their mark for the political party of their choice.

Millions of corruption-weary citizens do this in the hope those elected to power will govern competently - and with honesty and integrity - in the best interest of the people of South Africa.

Following its first Democratic Elections on 27 April 1994, South Africa was warmly welcomed by the international community of nations as a beacon of hope - promising a new era of peace, unity and unparalleled potential.

Tragically, just 25 years into its fledgling democracy, South Africa's huge potential is severely undermined by rampant state corruption, unrestrained theft, fraud, racketeering and the looting of public funds as well as gross maladministration that crippled vital state institutions.
