Its Time For Accountability - We Agree Mr Ramaphosa! Eradicate Corruption Now!

The 6th Democratic Elections has come and gone but voting patterns appear to remain relatively constant. Apparently, the majority of voters chose traditional allegiances over radical change.

The corruption tainted ANC won 57 percent support – shedding over 1,4 million votes compared to 2014. The DA also lost ground winning just over 20 percent of the poll but losing about 450 thousand votes in the process. The EFF support increased significantly - up by more than 700 thousand votes. The red beret's increase from 25 to 44 seats in the National Assembly does not bode well for the ruling party or the decorum of Parliament.

Of the smaller parties in Parliament, the FF+ tripled their support from 0.90% in 2014 to 2.38% in 2019 an increase of 249,129 votes. The ACDP, who won just 0.57% (104,039 votes) in 2014 struggled to crack 1% at the poll - managing a nominal increase of 42,031 votes or 0.84 percent in 2019.

Newly established parties standing on Biblical values like ACO, ECOFORUM and the Christian Political Movement did not perform well. Clearly, the vast majority of voters did not vote according to Biblical convictions. Some chose to support parties like the FF+ and Good that campaigned on minority rights.

Voters gave President Cyril Ramaphosa a mandate to fulfill his promises to South Africa. During campaigning, he repeatedly said, “The time for impunity is over, the time for accountability is now. Those guilty of corruption will be held accountable.” Christian citizens must pray that God will guide President Ramaphosa with wisdom, strength and courage to govern the nation competently and with integrity - in the best interest of the people.

I received several messages from Christian citizens outraged by the Sunday Times Article, [“Sex Lessons for Modern Grade 4s.”](#) Although many parents are shocked by revelations that “yoga, masturbation and LGBTQI instruction will be included in public school curriculums – I have been warning about [“Comprehensive Sexuality Education”](#) (CSE) since 2015 - to no avail.

CSE is a social engineering tool of the "International Planned Parenthood Federation" (IPPF) to indoctrinate innocent children with bizarre and high risk sexual practices. CSE is driven by UN agencies like UNESCO - [watch UNESCO video promoting sexual pleasure for 5 year olds here](#). South Africa is the only African nation that endorsed CSE at the UN and agreed to implement this dangerous and radical sexual rights agenda in its public schools.

I launched a [Petition](#) two years ago urging the Minister of Basic Education to reject CSE in SA schools. Very few Christian citizens took the time to sign the Petition. **Millions must sign this!** The Christian Church must urgently unite against this diabolical agenda to protect innocent children from state sanctioned sexual indoctrination.

Arlene and I depart for New York on Tuesday 14 May where I will speak at the [“It Takes a Family”](#) event at the United Nations (UN) to celebrate the *“International Day of Families”* on 15 May 2019. I will also attend a UN Committee meeting on 20 May to (hopefully) finalise my 2015 application for UN ‘Consultative Status.’ This status will grant FPI access to participate in key UN debates on family, parental rights, protection of children and religious freedoms.

CSE and other anti-family agendas are driven by UN agencies. Please pray that God will open this significant door for FPI so we can fight for the family at this global forum. Please also pray for us as we represent South Africa and Africa at this major pro-family event at the UN in New York.
