Arlene and I returned from New York on 22 May. By the Grace of God, the United Nations (UN) "Committee on NGOs" granted me a (late notice) opportunity to make an after-hours presentation to the full Committee and Member States on 20 May (Arlene's birthday).

My presentation at the "[It Takes a Family](#)" event at the UN on 15 May (*International Day of Families*) was also well received. Several Member States including the US, Russia and several African nations requested a copy of my speech.

After presenting on the work of [Family Policy Institute](#) (FPI) in South Africa and responding to questions from India, China, Nicaragua, Israel and Cuba, the Committee must now decide whether to grant or deny FPI special "Consultative Status" at the United Nations.

"Consultative Status" will grant me access and authority to engage in debates at the UN on issues critical to faith, family and freedom. It will also provide access to lobby Member State representatives to initiate and support pro-family resolutions

[Comprehensive Sexuality Education](#) (CSE) and other attacks against life, faith, family and religious freedoms emanate from the UN and are aggressively imposed on Member States by UN agencies like UNESCO that are, in reality, proxies for the radical global sexual rights movement.

That is why I must fight these battles at the United Nations - so we don't have to fight it in South Africa!

FPI's mandate and work has increased dramatically over the past five months. But our finances are lagging far behind. In short, we lack the financial resources

necessary to execute our God-given assignment.

I am way behind my fundraising goals for the first six months of 2019. As of 28 May 2019, FPI's deficit stands at R185,000. This setback will negatively affect the vital work of FPI in South Africa – something you and I cannot afford to allow at this critical time!

We are currently mobilising and equipping citizens to participate in the vital SA Law Reform Commission Discussion Paper on Sexual Offences – (Children & Pornography) to bolster legislative efforts to protect vulnerable children from exposure to harmful online pornography.

I am also monitoring the agenda to decriminalise prostitution in South Africa and the push to implement the dangerous "Hate Crimes" Bill that will criminalise certain parts of the Bible

Please note, our current deficit will severely hamper the continuity and effectiveness of FPI's vital pro-family work in SA precisely at the time we should be ramping up efforts to defend Biblical values.
