Family Policy Institute (FPI) has just 12 weeks left in 2019 to fulfil its pro-family objectives and complete its vital work in South Africa to defend the family and promote Biblical values in Parliament, the media and general society.

Arlene and I depart for Gauteng on 25 Sept to attend the "Celebration Conference" at Christian Family Church in Johannesburg. I will also attend the "*Dialogue with Religious Leaders*" in JHB on 26 Sept organised by the Department of Home Affairs to discuss the [controversial "single Marriage Act" policy](#).

In addition, I will meet with Pastors groups while in Gauteng to discuss the growing outrage against the proposed unilateral implementation of "Comprehensive Sexuality Education" (CSE) in South African schools in 2020.
